Operating out of five locations, Unison offers core services that include primary health care, case management and counseling, health promotion, Early Years programs, legal services, harm reduction programs, housing assistance, adult protective services, Pathways to Education and Diabetes Education Centre. Unison's mission is working together to deliver accessible and high quality health and community services that are integrated, respond to needs, build on strengths and inspire change.

Unison is committed to working from an inclusive, pro-choice, sex positive, harm reduction, anti-racist, anti-oppression and participatory framework.

At this time Unison is seeking to fill a Service Navigator position with our Unison Links Program. This is a Summer Career Student position based at our Keele-Rogers Site.

The primary duties of the Unison Links, Service Navigator will include:

1. Coordinate the Unison Links project to assist people in accessing and navigating health, legal, housing and community services in the community
2. Support the promotion of different summer activities and events in the community

To qualify for Summer Student position, candidates must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*<sup>3</sup>; and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
