Harm Reduction Outreach Worker

Unison is hiring two (2) part time, casual Harm Reduction Outreach Workers.

This position is 8 hours a week and pays \$15 an hour.

Job-Specific Responsibilities:

- Interact with community members who are active drug users and/or sex workers
- Actively perform street outreach on foot and using the TTC
- Distribute safer drug use and safer sex supplies
- Provide naloxone training and distribute naloxone kits
- Occasionally run kit making groups
- Occasionally staff our harm reduction offices
- Track the harm reduction supplies that you distribute
- Provide harm reduction education and information as needed
- Make referrals to services, program and workers as needed
- Maintain confidentiality according to Unison policies
- Attend harm reduction trainings, team meetings and network meetings
- Other duties as requested

Job-Specific Qualifications:

- Lived experience of drug use and/or sex work (active or former)
- Knowledge about crack use, injection drug use, and other types of drug use
- Ability to be open, non-judgemental and willing to learn
- Connected to one of the following two sets of communities:
 - Mount Dennis, Keele and Eglinton, Humber Boulevard, Jane and Woolner OR
 - Lawrence Heights, Marlee, Caledonia, Lotherton Pathway, St. Clair and Dufferin, St. Clair and Christie
- Able to work flexible hours, including evenings and possible weekends
- Good conflict resolution skills and a team player
- Ability to speak other languages an asset
- Comfort with active drug users, sex workers, homeless or street-involved individuals, youth, newcomers, LGBTQ+ population, individuals with a history of incarceration and individuals experiencing mental illness
