We are currently seeking a candidate for the position of Housing Help Worker. Reporting to the Manager, Housing Services and Harm Reduction Programs, the Housing Help Worker is responsible for delivering housing help services, programs and projects to targeted groups and communities.

Job-Specific Responsibilities:

- Provide intake and assessment for clients seeking general housing help services;
- Provide time limited housing search case management, short-term brief case management and support to clients including assessment, referral, education, budgeting, mediation and/or negotiation with landlords and/or other tenants.
- Ensure accurate housing client records by way of thorough outcome based recording of client encounters;
- See clients on both a scheduled and urgent basis;
- Assist clients in applying for and reviewing subsidized housing;

- Assist clients in applying for funds and any available financial resources to prevent eviction;
- Provide crisis intervention for clients facing housing related crises;

Job-Specific Qualifications:

- Post-secondary degree or certificate in Social Work/ Social Services Worker/ Community Worker or equivalent in training and experience
- Experience in case management and crisis intervention techniques
- Computer literacy with knowledge of Microsoft Office, Outlook, Excel, etc.
- Knowledge of community resources
- Experience with vulnerable, disadvantaged and low-income groups
- Knowledge of housing issues and tenant/landlord responsibilities
- Knowledge of Ontario Works and Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) legislation/regulations
- Strong oral and written English skills
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Interview and assessment skills
- Ability to work effectively with local agencies, landlords and volunteers
- Mediation and negotiation skills
- Experience in community outreach
- Experience serving Unison's priority populations (seniors with complex needs, people with mental health and addictions, LGBTTTQ+, and youth facing barriers).
- Ability to communicate in Spanish will be an asset
