

Artist Application Information and Form  
501 Oakwood Avenue Health Clinic

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Unison Health and Community Services is opening a new health clinic and is seeking applications from artists to develop art pieces such as, but not limited to prints, drawings, photography and paintings that will be installed in our space at 501 Oakwood Avenue at Vaughan Rd. The art work is intended to beautify the new site and put voices to the visuals focused on the themes of: community, health and youth. Up to 25 pieces of art will be accepted from the submissions received. \$150 will be awarded to those artists whose work is chosen.

In addition, a jury will select the top three works for an additional award. First prize is \$1000.00, Second Prize is \$750.00 and third prize is \$500.00. Each artist will have their name featured alongside their art work when mounted.

An application form must be completed and emailed with a visual image of your planned or completed piece. The application is found below in this document. If you know others who wish to receive an application form have them contact [sapphire.chaisson@unisonhcs.org](mailto:sapphire.chaisson@unisonhcs.org). You are required to send your application and art information to Sapphire at this email.

Note the deadline for submitting your application and image of your artwork is no later than 4:00 PM on July 15, 2018. Please include an Artist Application form with your art image using your full name as the file name.

All applications must be complete and in compliance with the submission requirements outlined in the application form. Incomplete applications and applications received after the deadline will not be accepted for consideration.

## Introduction and Project Description

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Unison Health and Community Services announces new Oakwood-Vaughan Health Clinic! The health clinic will provide a range of services with a focus on community members who face barriers to health care such as people living in poverty, isolated seniors, non-insured, people with complex mental health issues, those requiring interpretation and living with unstable employment. The clinic will be staffed by a physician, registered nurse, and health promoter and will provide client coordination and referrals. The site will include a specialized youth clinic that will focus on youth mental health and substance use needs, sexual and reproductive health and primary care.

### Seeking artwork

Unison Health and Community Services is seeking artists to create a work of public art that will serve to beautify and draw attention for our health clinic. The artwork will be mounted in the programming space, clinic offices and foyer at 501 Oakwood Avenue. Artwork must be no less than 140 square inches (i.e. 10 X 14, 12 X 12) and no larger than 2592 square inches (18 square feet) (i.e. 4 X 4, 3 X 6). We encourage most mediums of art; drawing, printing, installation, painting, photography, digital art, and decorative art (textiles and material, glass, wood, metal, mosaic, paper or other techniques). It should not have any sharp edges that might cause injury. Themes can include, but are not limited to, community, health and youth, the evolution of the Oakwood-Vaughan neighbourhood, the cultural history or a combination of any or all of those concepts. We hope to promote the creativity that allows all to express and trust themselves. We want artists to show a spirit of inquiry and exploration through their art pieces. This artwork will become a permanent fixture on our walls with artists names displayed.

### Artist Eligibility

We encourage proposals from all artists irrespective of race, religion, gender, sexual orientation or national origin. There is no age limit on submissions but as we will be a youth-focused health clinic, we hope for a number of youth submissions. We aim to reveal and discover new and established pieces from people who would like others to see their art.

### Information session

We will have an information session slotted for July 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 341 Oakwood Avenue, at the

Oakwood Village Library and Arts Centre from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. The information session will be open to anyone who is interested in learning more about the application process before the submission date of July 15<sup>th</sup> 2018. We will announce the next stage and answer all questions. Light refreshments and additional hard copy packages to be provided. All interested individuals are welcome to attend.

#### Submitting your application

All submissions must be original. All applications must be emailed to [sapphire.chaisson@unisonhcs.org](mailto:sapphire.chaisson@unisonhcs.org) no later than 4:00 PM on Sunday July 15, 2018.

Please provide an attachment with an image that best represents the concept of the piece you plan to submit. This is a mock up for the selection panel to identify the top 25 art pieces. The draft version can be a detailed sketch if it is a painting or drawing or it can be a photograph. Or if you have a completed piece please submit that image with your application. Ensure the quality of your image is crisp at 100% view when sending. Ensure an Artist Application form is submitted with the attached image of your piece with your full name as the file name.

#### Selection Procedure

Entries will be prejudged by a selection committee made up of community members and local artists. They will review the art submissions and application to select the 25 chosen works of art by July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018. All artists selected will be contacted at this time. Within a short time frame, we will ask the 25 individuals to attend an informal meet and greet on July 31<sup>st</sup>.

#### Meet and Greet

We will be inviting the 25 selected artists to a meet and greet that will take place at 341 Oakwood Ave, at the Oakwood Village Library and Arts Centre on July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 from 4-6 p.m. At the meet and greet, there will be an opportunity for artists to ask questions and for us to layout any details/ updates. We invite the selected artists to attend so that we can distribute \$150.00 each in an effort to reduce barriers to completing your art. Light snacks and refreshments will be available.

The top three art pieces and artists will be announced at the Open House and Art Unveiling event on November 7<sup>th</sup> 2018.

#### Submission of finalized artwork

All 25 artists must submit finalized art work on the days of September 18, 19, and 20<sup>th</sup> between 12 pm and 4 pm.

Drop off Address will be shared at the meet and greet on July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018.

At this time, you will be asked to sign an agreement related to permission for use of your work between yourself and Unison Health and Community Services.

Each physical submission should be presented in a sealed package clearly labeled with the following:

This deadline is a firm date. Submissions will not be accepted past date deadline. Drop off address is subject to change and will be announced at the meet and greet and by email.

#### Project Budget

If artists choose to submit more than one artwork piece, only one (may) be selected as one of the 25 accepted pieces. The honorarium for the each piece will be \$150.00 to support your completion of the artwork, to be provided in one installment on July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 at the Meet and Greet. The top three winners will be announced and awarded on November 7<sup>th</sup> 2018 at the open house. All work must be dropped off no later than September 20 2018, 4pm.
