Services are provided by nurses, doctors, nurse practitioners, dietitians, social workers, case coordinators and chiropodists.

Health Promotion

Good health is more than good medical care. We offer education and skill-building programs to increase knowledge, provide peer support and enhance coping skills. Individual and group activities include:

- Child and parenting programs
- Pre- and postnatal programs
- Seniors' programs
- Women's programs
- Youth programs

- Healthy lifestyles (eating, exercise, etc.)
- Chronic disease prevention
- Mental health and addictions
- Harm reduction (drug use)



Diabetes Education Program

The Diabetes Education Program provides services to people with diabetes and pre-diabetes. We offer free individual counselling and group education classes facilitated by a registered nurse and registered dietitian.

Community Services

Housing Program

Our housing counsellors help low-income people find and retain stable housing. Our services include rent bank, crisis referral to shelters, Toronto Community Housing applications and Streets to Homes follow-up services. We can also help you with eviction prevention, landlord mediation and housing searches.

Legal Services

Our legal team provides free advice and representation for residents, who meet financial and geographical eligibility criteria, primarily in the following areas of law: tenant issues, social assistance, human rights, employment issues, government pensions, immigration and notarization of legal documents.

Pathways to Education™

Pathways to Education works with high school students in defined neighbourhoods to improve school attendance and academic achievement, giving increased opportunities to pursue post-secondary education and develop career options. We offer tutoring, financial support, group mentoring and staff/advocacy support.



Adult Protective Services

We provide intensive case management and supportive counselling to adults with developmental disabilities who live independently in the community. Referrals are made through Community Living Toronto.

Community Building

Unison works with the community to identify and take action on community health issues such as decent housing, clean air, access to education and jobs.


