Operating out of five locations, Unison offers core services that include primary health care, case management and counseling, health promotion, Early Years programs, legal services, harm reduction programs, housing assistance, adult protective services, Pathways to Education and Diabetes Education Centre. Unison's mission is working together to deliver accessible and high quality health and community services that are integrated, respond to needs, build on strengths and inspire change.

Unison is committed to working from an inclusive, pro-choice, sex positive, harm reduction, anti-racist, anti-oppression and participatory framework.

At this time Unison is seeking a Nurse Practitioner-Registered Nurse -Extended Class – RN (EC) for our Jane-Trethewey site. The RN (EC) diagnoses and manages common health problems and diseases as part of the multidisciplinary, primary health care team.

Job Specific Responsibilities:

- Perform clinical duties within the scope of practice, including assessments, diagnosis, treatment, follow up, counseling, screening, education and referral. Duties may be performed at the centre through appointments and walk-ins and in the community through home visits and satellite clinics as required.
- Work with the primary health care team and other health centre teams to identify and take action on community health issues.
- Assist in the development and evaluation of protocols and procedures in order to provide optimal standardized care to clients.
- Other duties as required

Job Specific Qualifications:

- Sound clinical judgment and strong health assessment and diagnostic skills;
- Registration without restrictions in the Extended Class with the College of Nurses of Ontario;
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively independently and as a member of a multi-disciplinary team.

- Ability to work within a community-based context, with a culturally diverse community.
- Effective communication, interpersonal, organizational and administrative skills, including computer literacy skills specific to job requirements.
- Knowledge of issues affecting communities facing barriers to access in an urban environment.
- 3-5 years experience in a community-based setting or nursing experience in Primary Care/NP;
- Excellent triage and clinical skills;
- Strong computer skills;
- Well-developed interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills;
- Ability to speak another language is an asset.
- Willingness to teach /work with other professional disciplines and students.

The successful candidate must be able to work one Saturday shift per month.
